

HOW TO RETURN A BALLOT

At a Secure 24-Hour Ballot Drop Box

All boxes close at 7 pm on November 3, 2020

By Mail

Apply adequate postage to your Return Envelope.

Mail by October 26, 2020 to ensure enough time for delivery.

At a Voter Service and Polling Center (VSPC)

We expect high turnout at our VSPCs on Election Day.

Plan to vote before November 3, 2020 to skip the wait.

VOTE LIKE A PRO TIPS:

- Returning your ballot early speeds up Election results and may stop campaign calls.
- We cannot process a ballot envelope without a signature or with the wrong signature: make sure you sign YOUR ballot envelope as consistently as possible to avoid any delays in counting your vote.
- No postage is required if you use one of our convenient and Secure 24-Hour Ballot Drop Boxes located throughout the county.
- The US Postal Service (USPS) needs time to process and deliver your ballot. Therefore we recommend personally delivering your ballot to any of the secure locations listed above.
- If you choose to vote in person at a VSPC, make sure to bring a valid form of identification.
- You MUST sign the affirmation on your return envelope.
